Qualifications: Experience in cooking well balanced meals for large groups, institutions or catering is preferred. Knowledgeable of food services, health and safety regulations, WHMIS and standards as well as sanitizing procedures and materials. The working conditions include standing for long periods of time and involves some heavy lifting (20-40 lb.) on occasion. Fall Programmers

Camp Encounter, located north-west of Edmonton on the shore of Lac La Nonne, has opportunities for seasonal programmers to provide assistance to the Program Director and the Coordinator of Youth Evangelization with programming for campers during the fall session. The general responsibilities will include delivering specific programs; writing a final report; participating in all other camp activities and helping out other staff in their areas; participating in daily clean-up of camp and guiding campers through proper cleaning methods; taking part in staff training and staff development and creating and maintaining a safe environment for camping.

The specific areas of responsibilities or programming are: adventure programming including rock wall, archery, canoeing, challenge course and low ropes course. Fall programmers also provide spiritual and recreational programming.

Qualifications: Some knowledge of preparing and organizing program activities for campers and some experience or exposure to organized camping and/or youth ministry. Must have excellent written and verbal communication skills; an ability to work well with children and possess an attitude of service. An appreciation of the Catholic faith and the nature of a Catholic camp and a demonstration of Christian values in interacting with children on a regular basis is a requirement. Some heavy lifting (20-40 lb.) may be necessary in performing some of the job duties.
